Entry Requirements

- Be aged 16+
- Hold a completed AAT Accounting Intermediate qualification or equivalent

- Professional accounting studies e.g. ACCA; CIMA; ICAEW
- Possible first or second year exemption on an accounting degree course (will depend on the university)

- End of course exams (external)
