

Children and Young Persons Workforce (CYPW) Diploma – Level 3

A Children and Young Persons Workforce Diploma at level 3 will equip you with the knowledge and performance competency needed to support the learning and development of children and their well-being, in child care settings. It begins the required qualification pathway for this occupational area.

Programme Information:

- Child Care (CCLD) Level 3 NVQ
- Technical Certificate – Level 3 – Apprenticeship only
- Key Skills – Apprenticeship only:
 - Application of Number – Level 2
 - Communication – Level 2

Duration: 18 months (funding period) – 16–18 years
18 months (funding period) – 19+ years

Start Date: Anytime

Mandatory Units:

- Develop and promote positive relationships
- Develop and maintain a healthy, safe and secure environment for children
- Promote children's development
- Reflect and develop practice
- Protect and promote children's rights

Plus a selection of Optional Units which include: Planning; Assess children's progress; Stimulating environments for babies; Physical care of babies; Supporting children with SEN or disability needs

Entry Requirements:

- Be aged 16–24 and employed in the child care sector.
- Hold a completed Children's Care and Learning Development Level 2 qualification
- Be able to prove foundation performance competency through relevant employment experience and hold basic education to English/Maths GCSE Grade C or equivalent

Where it leads: Higher education; career progression

Assessment:

- Portfolio of evidence in both performance and theory
- Key Skills tests if required
