

## Level 2 NVQ In Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools

These NVQs have been developed following the revision of the Teaching/Classroom Assistants National Occupational Standards (NOS). The new NOS reflect developments in working with practice and the wider range of roles undertaken by support staff in terms of teaching assistants and LSA's. These qualifications are for those supporting teaching and learning in any type of school: primary (including foundation stage); secondary; special school; pupil referral units (PRUs) etc. They still relate directly to the role of teaching assistant but are broad enough in scope to include new roles and responsibilities such as:

- Cover supervision
- Pastoral support
- Bilingual support
- Subject support
- Special educational needs and additional support

**Course Duration:** 14 months

Candidates must complete five mandatory units from the following:

- Provide support for learning activities
- Support children's development
- Help to keep children safe
- Contribute to positive relationships
- Provide support for learning activities
- Support children's development
- Provide effective support for your colleagues

### Entry Requirements:

- Be aged 16-24 and employed in a school support role
- Be able to prove foundation performance competency through relevant employment experience and hold basic education to English/Maths GCSE grade C or equivalent. If you have lower grades, an entrance requirement assessment can be made
